

## Traffic counting results: Arbury Road, King's Hedges Rd, Gilbert Rd

### Count points

Arbury Road: opposite No. 19

King's Hedges: Not sure yet but think near Campkin Road (Ian to confirm)

Gilbert Road: opposite the school on Courtney way (traffic appeared usual)

### Traffic:

Counted cars, pedestrians, bikes and trucks passing a point on the road.

'Trucks' includes buses, 3-axel vehicles.

Motorbikes/mopeds counted as traffic (George)

No video taken. Used spreadsheet on Gilbert and Kings H. Pen and paper on Arbury.

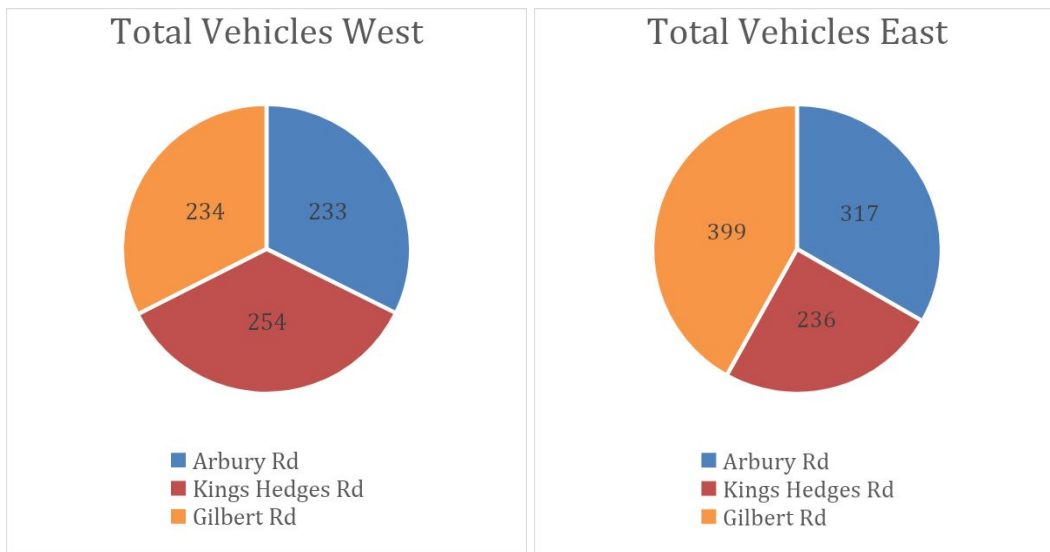

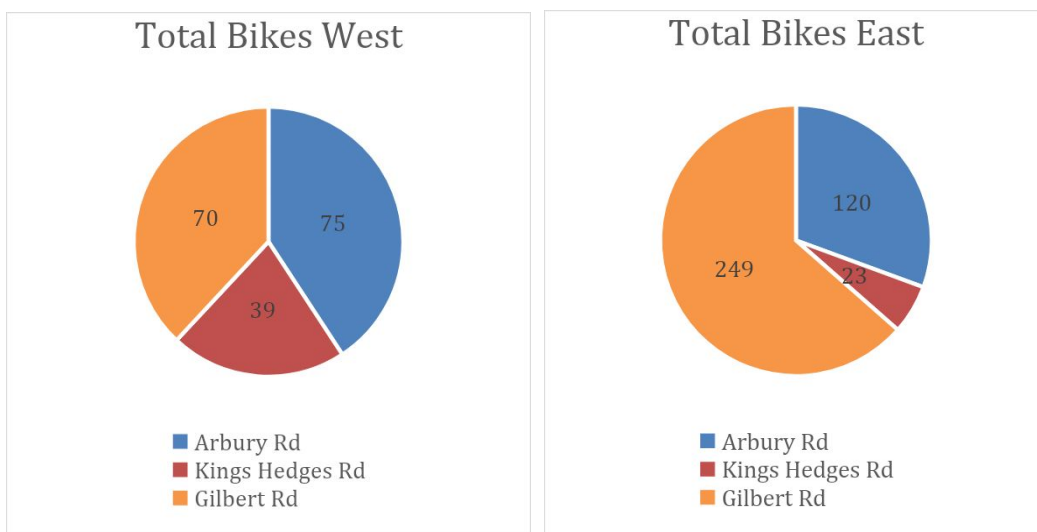
\*these include vans (for Arbury road the trucks probably numbered 3-4 in each direction).

Comparative Charts (counts)



West - Going west total vehicles and % are the same.

East - But east (towards town) Kings Hedges taking only about 25% of the total traffic! Arbury road takes 33%, Gilbert 42%.



West - Arbury has the most bike traffic! Surprising maybe, but we have a school (so does Gilbert Road but they also have safe bike lanes).

East - Bikes into town mostly down Gilbert road (63%) (they have school and bike paths) Arbury Rd get over 30% (a lot given no bike paths) Kings hedges (with bike paths) only 6%!

**Basically Kings Hedges on this data is under utilised. Given its much wider it should take more traffic.**
